Minutes of the February meeting- read and approved.

Old Business

1. 501c3- Washington State application has been sent. Tina submitted a copy of her personal check to be reimbursed for the \$20 application fee. Glenda reports attorney Mark Ponder is not available. Rich suggested she call Yvonne Ward to find a Pro Bono attorney.
2. Logo- discussion was held on final choices made from logo meeting held Tuesday, February 28, 2006. Kathy made motion/ Glenda 2nd/ motion passed.
3. Fire & Police Dinner- will be held in the East Room, per the menu decided at the February meeting. Tina has purchased the chicken breasts. We need Italian and Bleu Cheese salad dressing. Barbara will verify with Chief Calkins and email us with a final headcount. We are anticipating 30- 50 people based on last year's dinner. Glenda reports she made a test trifle and Valorie says it was very good.
4. Earth Day- meet at 9am at the Senior Center. We will focus on the Interurban Trail. Valorie has contacted the Edgewood Flower Farm and Wal-Mart for donations. Valorie will fill out any forms needed, with Tina assisting if needed. Park Board Paula needs to okay any plants so there are no invasive plants used. Rich, Tom Speller and others will be removing grass in the DOT area. Rich has small trash bags we can use for the clean up.
5. White River Blue Grass Festival - June 16th – 18th. Tentative times are 6pm to 9pm, 12noon to 10pm, 9am to 2pm. Zack Discoll is our headliner. The possibility of food vendors was discussed. Tina will contact the Auburn Lions and All Pro Pizza. Darrel will contact other food vendors from Pacific Days to see if they are interested.
6. Pacific Days- July 14th – 16th. Funtastic carnival rides have agreed to be there. We have no contract with them yet. Rich will talk to Boeing's Shanta Hyde about funding to make posters. Pacific Princess Information needs to be out this month for school PTA newsletters.

New Business

Guest Jim Schuncky, past Pacific firefighter and association member, asked for our endorsement of the annual Easter Egg Hunt held at the City Park, with the idea that we would take over that event beginning in 2007. The normal cost is \$500 - \$1000. This year it will be held Saturday, April 15 at 1pm. This will be in partnership with the City of Pacific for insurance purposes. Approximately 5000 eggs are used. They need to be

placed at the park about 12 noon. Tina will meet with Jim to learn how to organize the egg hunt for next year. Barbara made motion to endorse this egg hunt/ Glenda 2nd/ motion passed.

Brainstorming meeting- we felt we do not need it right now. We possibly will have a wrap up barbeque in August and will use that time for brainstorming.
