Minutes of the May 9, 2006 meeting

Attending: Chair Tina, Gene, Barbara, Darrel, Vice-chair Kathy, Valorie, Glenda, Arlene, Sec/Treas Ann. Guests Ryan Sackmann & Randy Mehl of Commercial Metal Recycling, and Tim Norman with Terry Home car show. Sharila Broin of Whitey's Auction.

Meeting called to order at 635pm

Minutes of April meeting were amended & approved. (Metro bus tickets)

Reports:

1. Treasurers: Bake Sale \$378, Trail donation \$15, Priest Company Donation \$100

Motion made to pay bills- reimbursements to Tina & Ann \$12 dues paid by Glenda, Valorie, Darrel & Kathy, Tina, Ann

Old Business:

1. 501c3- Randy Mehl will help Ann with budget & filing 501c3 paperwork. Valorie will contact attorney found on Craigslist. Mayor Rich says the auditing service is about \$100 a year & is so there are no improprieties.

2. Earth Day Wrap up- suggestions were made to have two crews to cover more area. Kathy made motion we focus on cleanup rather than planting. Valorie seconded, approved. Mayor Rich suggested next year having a community get together at the Park, entry fee would be a bag of trash. Valorie will send thank you notes to businesses & volunteers for this year's Earth Day. Tina has a signup sheet for watering the flowers planted on the trail.

3. White River Bluegrass Festival- Mayor Rich reports Ray Page has music set up. Rich will drop off flyers at the Orting Festival this weekend. Starting in October 2006, our gym will hold the bluegrass jams. Rich would like the tent to be set up on Thursday at the Park. Discussions included coordination of wristbands, volunteers, vendors. Barbara volunteered to be liaison between Mayor Rich and PP and overseer of WRBF. Tina passed info & wristbands to Barbara. It was suggested we give the vendors nametags in place of wristbands.

Kathy contacted KNBQ radio station for a possible on site broadcast. Kathy has all advertising out.

Auburn Lions wants a head count for food preparation. Darrel will call them with those numbers. Bathrooms need hourly walk through. We need a PP table right next to entry. Valorie motioned we waive Kathy's vendor fee in lieu of Kathy staffing the PP booth. Barbara seconded. Passed.

Darrel reports we have two vendors paid & one RV registration paid.

4. Pacific Days-

a) Tina made the map. We need to map vendors & carnival together. Randy & Ryan suggested a flow from carnival to vendors. Valorie will work with the carnival to coordinates with vendors. Rich says the mosquitoes will be sprayed in early June.

b) Seven vendors have already registered. The deadline is mid June.

c) Advertising is complete- radio, newspapers. Auburn Sign Company is doing the signs again. The dates need to be updated. Kathy will make sure school posters are complete.

d) The carnival contract still has not been signed. Ann will contact Aggressive Ministries about Sunday music details. Music discussions- Cassandra Speaks, 45 minutes, \$150-\$200. Knucklehead - NO per Kathy and Valorie. Kids Karaoke after the kids' parade on Friday evening with the finals on Saturday and then as the Saturday evening opening act. Ann will take over the Entertainment part of Pacific Days. Panama does not exist anymore- maybe Mr. Bill (they will contact Tina). Last year we had four acts. Tim's church has a band "The Bridge". Rich says last year we used \$1000. for music. Motion made to invite Cassandra Speaks. Seconded/ passed. The cost for the Sound System Guy is \$600. We need filler music.

e) Parade applications dated need to be updated. The deadline is the Friday the week before the parade. (July 7, 2006). End of the parade needs at least two people. We need to take into consideration Metro service and the train, rides back to the start of the parade from the park. Arlene received an email from Kevin Paustin about a possible parade band. Motion made to provide t-shirt for a 35-member band. Questions we posed about Dairy Queen's participation.

f) Princess- applications will go out to schools for distribution on May 19. Deadline is June 25. Glenda will ask Kathy's friend to make the sash. She is still looking for a crown.

g) Additional progress meeting for Pacific Days will be Tuesday, June 6 at 6:30pm at city hall complex.

Tim Norman told us about the May 21 Show & Shine car show at the Auburn Eagles for Terry Home and the Commercial Metals Hot Rod-a-roma at The Swiss. Ryan says there are many vendors and if we have a small car show this year, it could grow.

New Business:

- 2) Tina is resigning her position as Chair. Kathy is not willing to pick up the chair position. Tina can still do agendas and meetings. Darrel will put together an application to join Pacific Partnerships.
