

Pacific Partnerships  
Minutes of the June 12, 2007 meeting

The Minutes of the May 8 meeting were approved as read.

**Reports:**

1. Treasurer - Checking account balance \$5531.00 with \$1984.00 of that earmarked for Pacific Days.  
Motion made, 2<sup>nd</sup>, approved to accept treasurers' report
2. Marketing/ membership committee - dates were updated for the June issue of the Pacific Pulse newsletter. Approximately 2500 copies will be mailed out to all residents, businesses, etc in Pacific by the end of June.
3. Pacific Days committees
  - a. Advertising - Kathy says the school posters are out except in Sumner, we were not allowed to post them there. The retail signs will be ready to post by the end of June
  - b. Budget - Ann says we have \$1894.00 in the fund and are expecting more venter applications and donations.
  - c. Entertainment - discussions were about the Color Guard for Saturday and who will sing the National Anthem at the Opening Ceremonies. Beatrice has access to an accapella group and Glenda will check with her about availability.
  - d. Float - Barbara purchased silk flowers. The float looks good sitting near the post office, but needs new signs. Barbara volunteered to make new signs advertising Pacific Days.
  - e. Fund raising - "committee is done pounding pavement"
  - f. Kids parade – The kids will meet at 6:15p on Friday, July 13 in front of the Community Center. The Partnership will select the winners by applause. The pony cart will set the pace. Dairy Queen is sponsoring the Kids parade again this year and will hand out their coupons at the Park.
  - g. Miss Pacific Princess – The flyers are out. The deadline has been extended to June 15. Teri will form the committee and set the times for interviews. Glenda will post the bike signs at the kiosk.
  - h. Grand Parade – Glenda reports we have many applications. She has mapped out the staging area and the parade route. She has not received word from the Auburn Explorers and will email them again. The Enumclaw VFW post will be our color guard.
  - i. Parking - no report.
  - j. Partnership booth – Valorie distributed a sign up sheet to staff our booth. Each shift will be 2 hours in length. She needs pictures of this years events to post on the display boards. She would like a meeting on June 26 to finalize plans.
  - k. Signage – The city approved \$10,000.00 from the motel tax to pay for banners. Rich will put them up by the end of June. Valorie suggested we make permanent signs for next year. Kathy asked for volunteers to place the retail and yard signs.
  - l. Vendors – Darrel reports we have 35 vendors applied.
  - m. Volunteer – Kathy reports the Auburn Youth group have committed to staffing on Saturday from 2p to 6p. There may be some individuals that return on Sunday. The Volunteers Pizza Party will be on Monday, June 25 at Roundtable Pizza.

**Old Business:**

1. 501c3 – Ann reports the first application was rejected because of the word "partnerships" so she reapplied as Pacific Community Association DBA Pacific Partnerships. We are awaiting the results.
2. Polo Shirts – Darrel has samples to try on. The price is \$18.79 each payable to Darrel. He will order them so we have them by the end of June.

3. Pacific Partnerships' Participation need at Pacific Days. We need full participation of all members.

1. Pacific Partnerships participation.

2. City wide swap meet vs. citywide garage sale- Date is set for Saturday, August 18 for a Community Yard Sale. This will be held at the Community Center and the field next to it. A \$5 fee was discussed and will be finalized at the July meeting.
